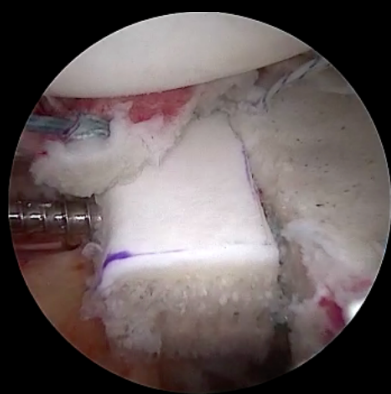

Hybrid fixation

Dr. Wong and his previous fellow: Dr. Campos-Mendez (2020-2021), just published a technique paper in the Arthroscopy Techniques journal. This represents the first published report of an arthroscopic anatomic glenoid reconstruction (AAGR) completed using both a screw and suture button as the fixation method!
